EQUITABLE ACCESS

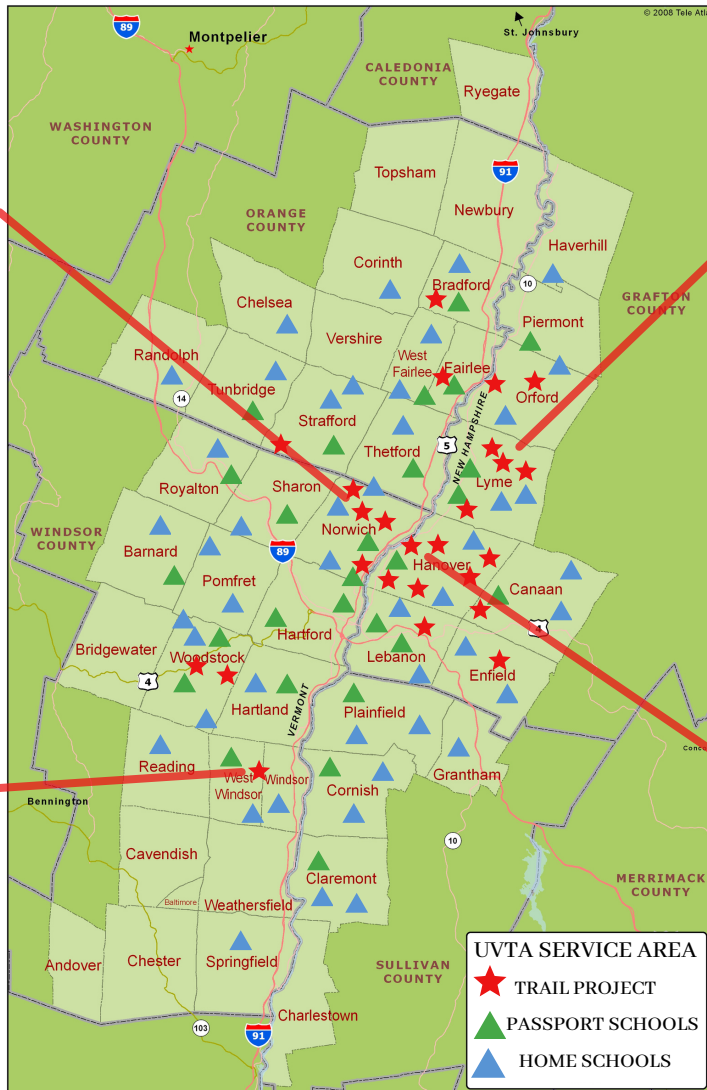
